Using filmed child testimonies, your students will work with our World Friendship Ambassadors to explore why some children may be bullied, why some may bully others, what unkind behaviour and discrimination looks like, as well as how we can work together to ensure everyone feels respected, no matter who they are. A wonderfully creative way to examine; 'What Would YOU Do?'

# ANTI- BULLYING WEEK 2023

#### **MONDAY 13TH NOVEMBER- FRIDAY 17TH NOVEMBER**

Bigfoot's interactive anti-bullying programmes for EYFS, KS1 and KS2, aim to encourage children to respect themselves and each other at school, in their homes, in the community, and on-line. This year we are proud to support the Anti-Bullying Alliance with their theme 'Make A Noise About Bullying' in order to help promote how important it is to have discussions about what bullying means to us and what we can do to stop bullying.

**ASSEMBLY & WORKSHOPS** 

### **CHOOSE RESPECT (KS2)**

'Choose Respect' takes an in depth look at how we form respectful relationships. The interactive assembly utilises filmed footage of a variety of character's stories to explore how we can manage our behaviour, language and actions in order to respectfully interact with each other. Throughout the 1 hour workshops students will explore; what empathy is and how we show it; how we can stand up for ourselves, and each other, safely; and how we can make sure we show respect to one another at home, in school and online.



# IT'S GOOD TO BE ME (KS1)

It's Good To Be Me', designed especially for KS1, explores self-esteem, friendship and respect. Using story, movement and puppetry within each 45 minute workshop we celebrate our differences and use our imaginations to consider the different ways we do and should treat each other. A wonderfully positive introduction to key anti-bullying and collective responsibility messages for younger children!

#### **CYBER BULLYING (KS2)**

Bigfoot's 'Cyber Bullying' workshops encourage students to consider how we communicate by phone and internet, along with the implications this can have at home, at school and in the wider community. Through a variety of drama and communication exercises, students will explore what cyber bullying is, identify the differences to 'face to face' bullying, and understand the effects on victims. Together students will discuss how to stay safe online, as well as create 'Cyber bullying adverts' to share information and advice with their peers. A brilliantly positive, fun and informative 1 hour workshop for students to safely explore a serious issue facing all young people today.

# R.E.S.P.E.C.T (KS2)

Respect' is a tricky concept to grasp; it refers to not only how you feel and act towards others, but also yourself. Therefore, if you are 'disrespectful' it can be damaging to how you are seen and treated by others, as well as how you view yourself. By exploring how we form and maintain relationships with each other, students will be encouraged to consider how respectful communication can assist in combating bullying in their school. This 1 hour workshop will enable participants to experiment with a variety of peer mediation techniques to foster kindness, whilst also learning the importance of embracing and celebrating our differences.

# I LIKE MYSELF (KS1)

I like myself, I'm glad I'm me, there's no one else I'd rather be. And I don't care in any way, what someone else may think or say. I'm having too much fun, you see, for anything to bother me!

This 45 minute interactive storytelling workshop uses Karen Beaumont's inspiring ode to self-esteem to encourage young students to appreciate everything about themselves, inside and out.

Messy hair? Beaver breath? So what! This little girl knows that being proud of being you is the most important thing, something all of us, regardless of age, would do well to remember!
