

This 'BIG Anti Bullying Experience' invites KS1 & KS2 students to take part in an exciting, large scale, learning opportunity with their peers.

WHAT WOULD YOU DO?

Up to 120 students can participate in each 60 minute session* whereby two Bigfooters in role will engage, enthrall and educate them about a particular topic/theme.

This thought provoking experience focuses on understanding how we maintain positive relationships and the importance of embracing each other's differences. Using filmed child testimonies, your students will work with our World Friendship Ambassadors to explore why some children may be bullied, why some may bully others, what unkind behaviour and discrimination looks like, as well as how we can work together to ensure everyone feels respected, no matter who they are. A wonderfully creative way to examine; 'What Would YOU Do?'

NEW WORKSHOP FOR 2024

DIVERSITY & ME (KS2)

This brand new workshop explores EQUALITY, DIVERSITY & INCLUSION and seeks to help children understand how important it is to not only support, but moreover embrace, *all* individuals.

By participating in this creative workshop, students will be invited to look more intricately at the challenges faced by those of diverse races, capabilities, or backgrounds. Together they will explore what it means to be treated as an equal, as well as what it means to be 'othered' and how this can have an adverse affect on a person's wellbeing and ability to achieve. Throughout the one hour session students will take part in a range of activities that will help them empathise with their peers, as well as challenge them to confront negative attitudes if and when they experience them.

By supporting all children to celebrate their uniqueness, whether they have SEND, are neurodiverse, or are from a different cultural, ethnic, social or family background to their peers, such as LGBTQ+, we will demonstrate that **everyone** has the right to thrive.

KS1 & KS2 WORKSHOPS

I LIKE MYSELF (KS1)

I like myself, I'm glad I'm me, there's no one else I'd rather be. And I don't care in any way, what someone else may think or say. I'm having too much fun, you see, for anything to bother me!

This 45 minute interactive storytelling workshop uses Karen Beaumont's inspiring ode to selfesteem to encourage young students to appreciate everything about themselves, inside and out. Messy hair? Beaver breath? So what! This little girl knows that being proud of being you is the most important thing, something all of us, regardless of age, would do well to remember!

RESPECT (KS2)

Respect' is a tricky concept to grasp; it refers to not only how you feel and act towards others, but also yourself. Therefore, if you are 'disrespectful' it can be damaging to how you are seen and treated by others, as well as how you view yourself.

By exploring how we form and maintain relationships with each other, students will be encouraged to consider how respectful communication can assist in combating bullying in their school. This 1 hour workshop will enable participants to experiment with a variety of peer mediation techniques to foster kindness, whilst also learning the importance of embracing and celebrating our differences.

ONLINE BULLYING (KS2)

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Bigfoot's 'Online Bullying' workshops encourage students to consider how we communicate online along with the implications this can have at home, at school and in the wider community.

This workshop focuses specifically on the causes, effects and consequences of negative behaviour online. Students will be encouraged, through a range of role play and storyelling activities, to identify the differences between cyber and face to face bullying behaviour and to understand the devastating effects a simple action online can have on both the target and the perpetrator. A fast paced, thought provoking, creative opportunity for students to explore what we can do together to ensure that we use the Internet safely responsibly and positively.
