CAUGHT UP IN THE NET (KS2)

Bigfoot invites up to 120 KS2 students (4 classes) to participate in a 60 minute interactive session with two Bigfooters as part of 'The BIG 'Safer Internet' Experience...

"This time it's different though. I mean at least this time they said to my face what they thought of me. Whoever is doing this, is doing it without revealing themselves and this time I can't even get away from it when I go home..."

This powerful interactive experience will support and empower KS2 pupils to establish positive and healthy online habits. Creative activities and storytelling techniques will support pupils to build their resilience to develop safe and appropriate long term behaviours and relationships in online communities. Together with Bigfoot's World Friendship Ambassadors, pupils will meet a variety of characters who explore the impact of their own, and others, online behaviour, with both immediate and far reaching consequences. The programme will consider how to have positive and respectful online relationships, as well as where to go for support when they have worries or concerns about their own or other's behaviour online.

Schools can book between 1 and 4 Big Experiences over the course of one day. Please note that all sessions must take place in a hall or large space.

Whilst staff members must be present in the space to meet appropriate pupil: staff ratios, all class teachers do not need to attend. This enables schools to use The Big Experience for staff meetings, PPA time and staff training.

ONLINE BEHAVIOUR (KS2)

Bigfoot's 'Online Behaviour' workshops encourage students to consider how we communicate online, along with the implications this can have at home, at school and in the wider community.

This workshop focuses specifically on the causes, effects and consequences of negative behaviour online. Students will be encouraged, through a range of role play and storytelling activities, to identify the differences between cyber and face to face bullying behaviour and to understand the devastating effects a simple action online can have on both the target and the perpetrator. A fast paced, thought provoking, creative opportunity for students to explore what we can do together to ensure that we use the internet safely responsibly and positively.
