Therefore, in order to to maximise the learning for each group, we advise that the audience should be made up of children of similar age/experience/level.*

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## Schools can choose from one of our five exciting BIG Experience options below...

### THE BIG 'CARNIVAL' EXPERIENCE; A Carnival Of Heroes

Spirit has become separated from The Notting Hill Carnival Parade only to re-appear in your school hall! From here a different kind of celebration and some contemplation ensues – that of black role models past and present. We invite schools to be part 'A Carnival of Heroes' by joining our Bigfooters as they sing, dance and explore with your students the amazing black men and women heroes who have helped shape our society.

### THE BIG 'SCIENCE' EXPERIENCE; Atomic Adventure

Soar into space on this interplanetary Big Adventure as our Bigfooters discover that space travel isn't quite as easy as they thought! Your students will explore the worlds of *Planet Physics*, *Planet Chemistry*, and *Planet Biology*, by taking part in exciting experiments, meeting crazy characters and helping our Bigfoot astronauts get back to Planet Earth. Inspired by "Once Upon An Atom" by James Carter (KS1) and "What's the Point of Science?" by A M Dassu, Ben Ffrancon Davies, and Edward Aves (KS2), this experience combines experiments, laughs and learning all wrapped into one big '*Atomic Adventure!*'

### THE BIG 'WINDRUSH' EXPERIENCE; Now & Then

This 60 minute interactive performance gives students an insight into the passengers who traveled to England in 1948 on board The Empire Windrush. Reflecting on the incredible voices and experiences of Black people in post war Britain, this imaginative 'show' uses real stories to celebrate the legacy of the Windrush generation. Participants will be taken on a journey through time using music, dance, storytelling and imagination in order to explore the people, places and events that have helped shape multi cultural Britain.



### THE BIG 'LITERACY' EXPERIENCE; Wolf On Trial

What really happened to the 3 Little Pigs?! Everybody thinks they know this age old story already, but has anyone ever stopped to hear what the Wolf has to say about what happened? Is he really as big and bad as they say, or is it all just a case of porky pies? You are invited for 'Jury Service' for the trial of Alexander T Wolf. Meet Judge Chief as she unpicks the evidence with some help from the pigs themselves, the police, as well as CCTV footage. Hear straight from the horse's (well, the Wolf's!) mouth, his version of events, before you are left to decide whether he is guilty or not in this '*Wolf On Trial*' extravaganza!

### THE BIG 'ANTI BULLYING' EXPERIENCE; What Would YOU Do?

This thought provoking experience focuses on understanding how we maintain positive relationships and the importance of embracing each other's differences. Using filmed child testimonies, your students will work with our World Friendship Ambassadors to explore why some children may be bullied, why some may bully others, what unkind behaviour and discrimination looks like, as well as how we can work together to ensure everyone feels respected, no matter who they are. A wonderfully creative way to examine; '*What Would YOU Do?*'
