Meet Judge Chief as she unpicks the evidence with some help from the police, CCTV footage, as well as the three little piggies themselves. Hear straight from the horse's (well, the Wolf's!) mouth, his version of events, before you are left to decide; is he guilty or not guilty?!

By participating in our 'Big Literacy Experience' students will:

- speculate and hypothesise about what are the true versions of events based on both books; what they think they know and what they are presented by us.
- use spoken language to hypothesise and explore new thoughts together.
- participate in a unique theatrical performance that will require them to discuss and debate what is presented to them.
- consider and evaluate different viewpoints from the original text, our performers, and each other.

PLAY IN A DAY (KS1 & KS2)

RAPSPEARE (KS2)

Rapspeare has been designed to inspire students to not only explore Shakespeare's verse, but also break any preconceived stereotypes regarding the bard. Using contemporary rap and hip hop beats they will discover how to connect with Elizabethan language by smashing apart the iambic pentameter and learning to articulate Shakespeare in a fresh and exciting new way.

During the workshop students will be encouraged to explore one or more of Shakespeare's speeches through a variety of unique and inspiring activities and tasks. By the end of the session students will have learnt and performed a piece of Shakespearean verse and will be equipped with the techniques required to deliver this to the rest of their peers.


