KNIFE CRIME

POWERFUL CHOICES

Designed specifically for Year 5, 6 and 7 students, 'Powerful Choices' is an early intervention approach to understanding key messages around the topic of knife crime, gang violence and keeping safe.

Students will participate in a 45 minute interactive assembly, in which a narrator introduces them to the fictional story of 11 year old Gabriel, who has recently struggled with making some difficult choices about the friends he is spending time with. He has been feeling pressure to join in on some behaviour he doesn't like, especially as his friends have started talking about knives. Sometimes Gabriel finds it hard to talk about his worries to the grown ups in his life; he doesn't know where to start and he doesn't want to let them down.

Following the assembly groups of up to 30 students will have the opportunity to explore key issues in more depth and to consolidate their understanding of the laws surrounding and consequences of knife crime. They will use various drama skills to consider character choices and consequences whilst also looking at how to have positive, respectful relationships with their peers, as well as how to have difficult conversations with adults and how they can access support.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES

This programme aims to help children & young people:

- Understand how to keep themselves and others safe
- Manage friendships and peer pressure
- Understand the law around carrying knives
- Explore the consequences of knife crime and gang violence on the victim, the perpetrator, their families and the wider community
- Identify how to access support and who can help them
