ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

During our puppetry masterclass, the students will gain an understanding of the principles of puppetry (breath, weight and focus) and have the chance to create and animate their own puppets. They will work both independently and as a team to bring their puppets to life and learning how puppetry can be used as a powerful form of storytelling in theatre. We will look at different puppetry forms and see how adding puppetry into a production can open up new possibilities that cannot be achieved by actors alone.

WORKSHOP AIMS & OBJECTIVES

- To understand the principles of puppetry.
- To work both independently and as a team to animate a puppet.
- To learn about different forms of puppetry.
- To understand different ways that puppetry can be used within a production.
- To work in groups to create a short scene with our puppets*

Format

Schools can book either 2 x 2 hour workshops or 1 x 4 hour workshop to take place over the course of a half day or full day. We can work with up to 30 students per workshop from any key stage or year group.
